4. What is the total number of hours dedicated to classes each week?

The weekly hours dedicated for Kelas KAFA Rendah (Primary) is 2 hours, and Kelas KAFA Menengah (Secondary) is 2 hours 30 minutes to meet JAIS requirements.

5. What learning materials are provided for the programme, and are students required to purchase any additional resources?

All learning materials and resources are provided by JAIS. Parents are responsible for covering the cost of these materials.

6. What distinguishes this programme's syllabus from the Pendidkan Islam (Islamic Education) classes offered during regular school hours?
